The court held a status conference on the record with counsel for the parties in the within case, as well as the Monitor, on June 13, 2017, at 10:00 a.m. At the conference, the Monitor and the parties updated the court on progress made over the last six months toward several important milestones, as well as continued challenges confronting the City of Cleveland. Specifically, the Monitor and the Department of Justice praised the City's efforts in developing use of force and crisis intervention training, while acknowledging that significant issues remained in regard to the Equipment and Resource Plan; the Body-worn Camera Policy; and the Office of Professional Standards investigation backlog. Additionally, the Monitor noted the substantial effort already devoted toward developing the Community and Problem-Oriented Policing Plan. These matters were also outlined in detail in the Monitor's Third Semiannual Report. (ECF No. 135.)
