Sir:

Reported for duty at 8:30 A.M. this date in company with Patla, Dever #990 and Haney #258, read reports, complaints and performed the following assignments.

At this office requestioned Elijah Abercrombie, 773 E. 93 St. relative to the malicious destruction of property of Donald King, 3713 E. 151 St. Subject again denied that he had ever received money from King and had seen him only about six times in his life. Subject was then booked at the Detective Bureau on the warrant that was issued, this was for violation of R.O. 2901.38, (blackmail-felony). Subject was taken to the statement room but he refused to make a statement.

Made reports which are connected with the investigation of Donald King and the bombing of his home. Report made on the questioning of Sampson Powell, known muscle man and suspected of working for Alex Birns. Report made on the telephone numbers which were confiscated from Elijah Abercrombie.

Went to the residence of Sam Elmore, 3189 E. 132 St., reported clearing house figure who had been given a beating by muscle men of Alex Birns. This subject wanted for questioning and possible statement, failed to find this person at home, word was left with his wife for Sam Elmore to come to this office.

On information received from a confidential source, went to 14 05 Mixverton Ave., the residence of Dollree Mapp who is known to this office and has previous arrest for clearing house violations. Information had been obtained that a person was hiding out at this address who was wanted in connection with the bombing of Donald King and that certain evidence was conveyed to this address. Dollree Mapp resides on the second floor, subject was at home but refused to let us into her home. After considerable delay a search warrant was obtained and entrance gained. Arrested Dollree Mapp and a Vergi Ogletree for investigation, they were conveyed to the Detective Bureau where they were booked. Ogletree is known to be connected with a clearing house operation and also the California Gold policy house. In the basement we found a foot locker which contained a large amount of policy paraphernalia in the form of balls and business from the California Gold and Interstate policy houses. In the second floor residence of Dollree Mapp we found a number of books of a pornographic nature. Special report to be made of this and the prosecutor to be consulted.
